

FACTS**WHAT DOES CLEARVIEW CORRESPONDENT SERVICES, LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?****Why?**

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- account balances and transaction history
- credit history and assets.

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Clearview chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do**How does Clearview protect my personal information?**

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Our employees are bound by our Code of Ethics and policies to access personal information only for legitimate business purposes and to keep information about you confidential.

How does Clearview collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- give us your contact information or open an account
- use your credit or debit card or make a wire transfer
- make deposits or withdrawals from your account.

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you.

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. [See below for more on your rights under state law.]

Definitions**Affiliates**

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Our affiliates include financial companies such as banks, consumer finance companies, securities broker-dealers, insurance agencies, investment advisors, and mortgage companies.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Nonaffiliates we share with can include government entities, and companies that assist in servicing your account(s) with us.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *Clearview doesn't jointly market.*

Other important information

You may have other privacy protections under some state laws. We will comply with applicable state laws as to information about you.
